

On February 8 you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration _discussion_of_JIC-5G-C_5929,_Visalia,_California._The___ question in this grievance is whether management properly utilized an acting supervisor in a clerk craft overtime assignment.

It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows:

- An acting supervisor (204-B) will not be utilized in lieu of a bargaining-unit employee for the purpose of bargaining-unit overtime.
- The PS Form 1723 shall determine the time 2. and date an employee begins and ends the detail.
- An employee detailed to an acting supervisory position will not perform bargaining-unit overtime immediately prior to or immediately after such detail unless all available bargaining-unit employees are utilized.
- Due to the various situations that could occur, each set of fact circumstances will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
- Therefore, this case is remanded to the 5. region for determination and compensation of the by-passed employee.
