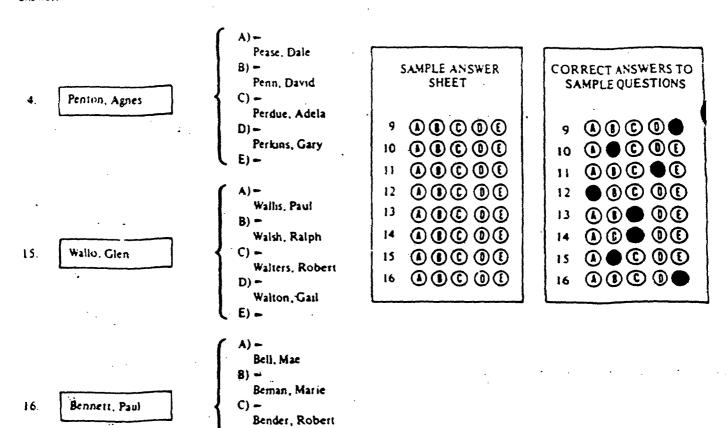
Sample Questions 9 through 30 - Clerical Aptitude
