The subject Step 2 grievance was discussed with you on September 1, 1982 in accordance with Article XV, Section 2, of the National Agreement. This letter will confirm our settlement of this grievance.

As a final and complete settlement of the subject grievance and without prejudice to the position of the United States Postal Service in this or any other case, and with the understanding that the Union shall not cite this settlement in any other grievance proceeding, or any other forum, the following resolution has been entered into by the parties.

The Employer will make available for inspection by the Unions all relevant information necessary for collective bargaining or the enforcement, administration or interpretation of this Agreement, including information necessary to determine whether to file or to continue the processing of a grievance under this Agreement. Upon the request of the Union, the Employer will furnish such information, provided, however, that the Employer may require the Union to reimburse the USPS for any costs reasonably incurred in obtaining the information.

If management deems it necessary to "clean" a document for privacy purposes or irrelevant entries prior to affording review and/or copies to the Union, the labor expense entailed in that operation will not be charged to the Union.

It is understood that this settlement does not add to or otherwise amend Article 31, Section 2, of the 1981 National Agreement.

This settlement represents the complete and final resolution of the subject grievance and all issues pertaining thereto.
