Recently we met in prearbitration discussion of H1C-3D-C 38668, Florence, Alabama. The question in this grievance is whether a full-time regular employee on limited duty may be scheduled day-to-day with varying reporting times.


It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows.


1. Full-time regular employees on limited duty will not be scheduled day-to-day with varying reporting times.
2. Employees injured on duty will be scheduled in accordance with the ELM, part 546.141.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement to settle this case, withdrawing H1C-3D-C 38668 from the pending national arbitration listing.
