RE: STAFFING SOFTWARE

At the May 2001 Central Region Maintenance Educational Seminar the delegates requested and we promised to provide them with copies of the most current Postal Service staffing software. After lengthy discussions with the Postal Service, we were finally permitted to copy their staffing software and distribution of the staffing software was made to the delegates.

The Postal Service's Staffing software is contained on two staffing CD's which are enclosed in this mailing:

- The Maintenance Workhour Estimator and the Postal Service's support 1. documentation for Mechanization and Building Maintenance, 2.
 - The MS 47, Version 2.6d, for custodial staffing¹.

These are the most current staffing CD's and installation of the CD's is relatively easy. Follow the normal program installation prompts on your computer when installing the Workhour Estimator. Installation of the MS-47 program requires a few additional steps. To install the MS-47 program follow these steps:

- Α. Click on the ICON "My Computer"
- Β. Click on the ICON for your computer's CD drive
- C. Click on the FOLDER titled "MS-47 Ver.2.6.d"
- D. Click on the ICON titled "Setup"
- Ε. Follow the installation prompts.

This Software Modification Order (SMO) releases Automated MS-47 Version 2.6b software. The purpose of this SMO is to upgrade all previous versions of the Automated MS-47. This update must be completed to be compatible with the Workhour Estimating Software Package.

Attachments 1 through 4 provide instruction and information related to the installation and use of the new software. After completing the modification, fill out Attachment 5 and return it to the indicated address.

Enclosed with this SMO is a set of two 3.5-inch diskettes for upgrading and backing up the Automated MS-47 v2.6b.

MS-47 FILE BACKUP

Use this procedure to back up data from previous versions of the Automated MS-47 program.

The following diskette is provided with this SMO to complete the procedure:

• MS-47 BACKUP DATA (pre-formatted and defect free)

NOTE: If a large number of files are to be backed up additional data diskettes will be required. Use formatted diskettes containing no files.

When the MS-47 program performs a backup, the data from a directory is compressed into a file and then copied to a diskette. The backup operation is a standalone MS-47 operation, no additional utilities are required to perform the backup. This is not part of a MS-DOS backup or any other file backup program.

- 1. Insert the MS-47 BACKUP DATA diskette into drive A. (If your system configuration uses drive B for backups, insert diskette into drive B.)
- 2. Select Back Up from the file menu. See Figure 1-1.

INSTALLING AUTOMATED MS-47 2.6B

Use this procedure after successfully backing up data from previous versions as instructed in Attachment 1. This procedure installs the MS-47 2.6b program files from a diskette to the computer hard drive.

The following diskette is provided with the SMO to complete the procedure:

Automated MS-47 v2.6b Install Disk

The installation program sets up a complete, working installation of the Automated MS-47 program. No previous program files are required for this installation. For the procedures that follow, "[ENTER]," refers to the instruction to press the keyboard, "ENTER" key.

- 1. With the system at the C:> prompt, insert the Automated MS-47 Install diskette into drive A.
- 2. Start the installation program, type: A:INSTALL [ENTER].
- 3. Observe the install program startup screen. To continue after reading the text press: [ENTER].
- 4. To accept the default source diskette, press: [ENTER].
- 5. The program displays the README.TXT file. After reading this file, press: [ESC].
- 6. To accept the default destination drive and directory, press: [ENTER].
- 7. The program responds by reporting the progress of the installation.
- 8. When the install program quits, the system returns the prompt, C:\MS47V26B>.
- 9. Remove the installation diskette.
- 10. Continue to next procedure.

STARTING THE AUTOMATED MS-47

After successfully completing the installation, use this procedure to create a MSTEST directory and to enter the system default information.

- 1. From the C:\MS47V26B directory, start the program, type: MS47 [ENTER].
- 2. The program starts and displays the opening screen with a dialog box.
- 3. No inventory data is available to the program following a new installation. After starting the program you must create a new sub-directory. To create a new directory, press: [ENTER].
- 4. The program asks for a directory name, type: TEST [ENTER].
- 5. The program creates the MSTEST directory and builds an empty inventory data base.
- 6. From the FILE menu, select: System Defaults.
- 7. The program responds by displaying the system defaults entry screen. See the example in Figure 3-1.

MS-47 FILE RESTORE

Use this procedure to restore data to MS-47 version 2.6b from a floppy diskette and perform a program update.

The restore operation requires that you to select the compression type of the file. To insure compatibility with prior versions, a restore method is provided for each compression type.

- PKZIP
- MSCE
- INTERNAL
- 1. From the C:\MS47V26B directory, start the program, type: MS47 [ENTER].
- 2. The program starts and displays the main menu screen. Insert the MS-47 BACKUP DATA diskette into drive A.
- 3. From the FILE menu, select: **RESTORE**. Observe the RESTORE DATABASE FILES screen. See Figure 4-1.

- 4. On the bottom row of the screen is the restore method. Change the restore method, press: [F10]. Observe the RESTORE METHOD dialog box. See Figure 4-2.
- 5. Select the PKZIP restore, type: P.
- 6. Choose all files, select: GLOBAL.
- 7. The program responds by restoring all PKZIP files.
- 8. From the File menu, select: RESTORE.
- 9. Change the restore method, press: [F10].
- 10. Select the MSCE restore, type: M.
- 11. Choose all files, select: GLOBAL.
- 12. The program responds by restoring all MSCE files.
- 13. From the File menu, select: RESTORE.
- 14. Change the restore method, press: [F10].

- 15. Select the INTERNAL restore, type: I.
- 16. Choose all files, select: GLOBAL.
- 17. The program responds by restoring all INTERNAL files.
- 18. From the File menu, select: Program Update. See Figure 4-3.
- 19. The program responds by performing special file maintenance to each directory.
- 20. This concludes the procedure. Continue to Attachment 5.
