Dear Mr. Anderson:


Recently, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H1C-4A-C 6306. The question in this case is whether the Postal Service worked casual employees in lieu of PTF's. It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows:


Four PTF's who did not work on April 7, 1982, will be paid eight (8) hours each. Seven PTF's who did not work on April 8, 1982, will be paid eight (8) hours each. Nine (9) PTF's who did not work on April 9, 1982, will be paid eight (8) hours each. The pay will be at the applicable straight time rate.

This issue as to which PTF's will receive the backpay outlined above is remanded to the Labor Relations Department, Central Region, for determination.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement H1C-4A-C 6306 from the pending national arbitration listing.
