Dear Hr. Wilson:

On February 3, you met with Hort Hiller in pre-arbitration discussion of EBC-5F-C-11643 and EBC-5F-C 11827. After a discussion of the issues, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of these cases.

When, in accordance with Article 12, Section 4 of the National Agreement, it is proposed to reassign within an installation an excess employee serving as a steward, said employee, per Article 17, Section 3 of the National Agreement, will not be involuntarily transferred from his station or branch if there is work for which that employee is qualified in that station or branch.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withrawing E8C-5F-C-11643 and H8C-5F-C 11827 from the pending national arbitration listing.
