In previous discussions with Labor Relations Team Leader Patrick Devine of your staff, we believe that this information is accessible through the USPS' GAT system.

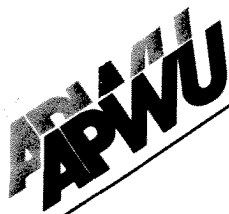
