Employees converted to full-time pursuant to the Memorandum do not occupy full-time positions as defined in Article 12. The withholding of vacancies is intended to accommodate excessed employees by placement in residual vacancies vacated by full-time regular employees. The parties have agreed by separate Memorandum that withheld vacancies must In that employees converted under the identified. Memorandum are only assigned to duties, hours and days of work, withholding will not accommodate excessed full-time employees.

It is the position of the American Postal Workers Union that PTFs who meet the requirements of the Memorandum must be converted to full-time notwithstanding the withholding of full-time positions pursuant to Article 12.
