On several occasions, the most recent being July 27, 1984, we met as representatives of the national level maximization committee to review the above-captioned case.


The question raised in this case is whether an employee must work 39 hours or 40 hours per week during the six month period in order to meet the conversion criteria as required by the "maximization" Memorandum of Understanding.

After further review of this matter we agreed that if the subject employees worked 39 or more straight time hours per week over the six month measuring period as required, the employees are to be converted to a full-time status.

Accordingly, this matter is hereby referred to the regional level for further processing as indicated above.
