Dear Mr. Wilson:

On April 13 and April 28, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure as set forth in Article 15, Section 2, of the National Agreement.

The dispute at issue in the instant grievance is whether local management properly compensates part-time flexible clerks who are called into work on a day they had not been scheduled to work.


After further review of the matter, we mutually agreed that there was no National interpretive issue fairly presented as to the meaning and intent of Article 8 of the National Agreement. The issue of part-time flexible work hour guarantees and the meaning of Article 8, Section 8, have previously been resolved by Arbitrator Garrett in National Case N-E-123(12-1-72).


Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to Step 3 for further development and consideration if necessary by the parties.
