Dear Mr. Freeman:

On June 25, 1985 and again on July 3, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the grievant was properly compensated for work and leave hours for the week February 2, 1985 to February 8, 1985.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that when a PTP employee has been previously granted annual leave, such leave will not be unilaterally changed to a nonscheduled day, solely to make the PTF available for an additional day of work at the straight time rate. Based upon the above consideration, the grievant will be compensated at the overtime rate for hours worked on February 8, 1985. In addition, payment for 8 hours of annual leave for February 4, 1985 should be made.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.
