Dear Mr. Overby: On November 4, 1981, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8N-3P-C-25588 and H8N-3Q-C-26319. After a thorough discussion of the issue, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent full settlement of these cases:

- When a part-time flexible employee is notified prior to clocking out that he should return within 2 hours, this will be considered as a split shift and no new guarantee 1.
- When a part-time flexible employee, prior to clocking applies. out, is told to return after 2 hours, that employee must be given another minimum guarantee of 2 hours work or
- All part-time flexible employees who complete their assignment, clock out and leave the premises regardless pay. of interval between shifts, are guaranteed 4 hours of work or pay if called back to work. This guarantee is applicable to any size office.
