Dear Mr. Wilson:

On April 27, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved whether adding window relief duties to a Bulk Mail Clerk assignment violates the National Agreement.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. We agreed that the position description for Bulk Mail Clerks includes window service duties. We also agreed that there is no provision for the addition of an item by local management to an established Standard Position Description.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for application of the above and further processing if necessary.
