On March 19, 1993, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance involves reverting several maintenance craft position and whether the grievance is timely.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case.


We further agreed that Article 38.4.A., subsections 2 and 3 establishes a 40 day time limit for completing the reversion process.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
