Dear Mr. Adams:

On November 14 you met with Frank Dyer in prearbitration discussion of EIC-4P-C 10813, Columbus, Ohio. The question in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by not calling the grievant in to work overtime on his nonscheduled day when the day in question followed 2 days of annual leave.

It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows:

1. Normally, employees on the OTDL who have annual leave immediately preceding and/or following nonscheduled days will not be required to work overtime on their off days.
2. However, if they so desire, employees on the overtime desired list may advise their supervisor in writing of their availability to work a nonscheduled day that is in conjunction with approved annual leave.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing EIC-4P-C 10813 from the pending national arbitration listing.
